

**City of Maple Heights
Emergency Council Meeting Minutes**

Maple Heights City Hall

September 23, 2014

Council President Jackie Albers called the meeting to order at 8:40 p.m. and called the roll.

ROLL CALL: Those present were Council President Jackie Albers, Council Members Alex Adams, Toni Jones, Anthony Cefaratti Ron Jackson, Richard Trojanski and Edwina Agee. Council member Bill Brownlee was absent and excused. Also present were Mayor Jeffrey Lansky, Human Services Director Linda Vopat and Clerk of Council Katherine Unger.

Mr. Trojanski made a motion, seconded by Mr. Jackson to suspend all regular items and reports from the meeting except the legislation. All voted aye, none opposed, the motion passed.

LEGISLATION:

ORDINANCE NO.: 2014-71

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE CLERK OF COUNCIL TO DELIVER TO THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE MAPLE HEIGHTS CHARTER TO LIMIT THE USE OF PHOTO-MONITORING DEVICES TO DETECT CERTAIN TRAFFIC LAW VIOLATIONS, IN THE CITY OF MAPLE HEIGHTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Mr. Jackson made a motion, seconded by Ms. Jones to suspend the rules and place the legislation on its third and final reading. All voted aye, none opposed, the motion passed.

Mr. Cefaratti stated that he would like to make a notation in the minutes and stated that the Council has been told by the Supreme Court that the Council must vote “yes” on this legislation, and he takes offense to that because as an elected official, he stated that he should have the right to vote the way he wants.

Mr. Adams made a motion, seconded by Mr. Trojanski to adopt the legislation. All voted aye, none opposed, the motion passed. The legislation passed by the vote of 6 ayes, and 0 nays.

There being no further business to come before this Council, Council President Jackie Albers adjourned the meeting at 6:42 p.m.
