LEAF PICKUP RETURNS TO MAPLE HEIGHTS THE WEEK OF OCTOBER 16 THROUGH MID DECEMBER!



Each street will have at least three pickups. There is no set schedule for when leaves will be picked up, Three Z (the contracted company) will begin pickup on the East side of Maple Heights and work their way to the West side and then return again to the East side working West. If there are questions they can be contacted at 216-524-6668.

Important tips: Get your leaves out on the tree lawn as quickly as possible. Make sure that there are no bushes, sticks, etc in the leaves or they will not pick them up. Do not put your leaves on the curb or in the street so the leaves do not go into the street sewer.

TAKE YOUR TRASH CANS IN AFTER PICKUP ON FRIDAY. Garbage cans cannot be put out for collection earlier than 5PM the day before pickup. Garbage collection in District 2 is on Friday. Trash receptacles must be taken back into your yard the day of collection and not left out for days after collection. You will be ticketed for leaving your cans out.

Recycling is every other week. If you live on the streets west of Dunham Road, your next recycle pick up will be October 27th and every two weeks after that date. If you live on streets east of Dunham Road, your next recycle pickup will be November 3rd and every two weeks after that date. You do not have to put out the recycling can every two weeks if a monthly pickup is better for you, but watch your dates.

REMEMBER TO VOTE ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7TH. MAPLE HEIGHTS HAS THE POLICE (ISSUE 29) AND FIRE (ISSUE 30) RENEWAL LEVY ON THE BALLOT. This is not a tax increase but a renewal to prevent a reduction of staffing of Police and Fire. We appreciate your support!

- **NEW NUISANCE ORDINANCE PASSED.** The Nuisance ordinance covers all the quality of life issues and criminal activities, abandoned homes, etc. Rental properties can have their rental license suspended under this ordinance. - **MAPLE HEIGHT MOBILE PANTRY** is opened the first Saturday of each month from 9AM to 11:30AM with seasonal fresh fruits and vegetables. It is located at 20760 Southgate Park Blvd.
- **UTILITY BILL ASSISTANCE through CHN Housing Partners.** The Winter Crisis program begins November 1. For an appointment call 216-518-4014. Winter Crisis offers income eligible homeowners or tenants to help you catch up on past due utility bills or utility disconnection, and establish affordable monthly payments for utility bills through the PIPP PLUS program. CHN Housing Partners also has financial assistance for water/sewer bills, call 1-888-901-1222 and programs for weatherization call 1-888-377-3774 #2 to assist with whole house insulation, furnace repair or replacement, hot water tank replacement and plumbing and sewer repairs.
