MOTION FOR ADOPTION BY:

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR CURRENT EXPENSES AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY OF MAPLE HEIGHTS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2020, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council hereby approves and adopts the 2020 Appropriations Budget, which is on file in the office of the Finance Director and attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Maple Heights during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the City's Charter and Codified Ordinances and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City and for the further reason that the 2020 Appropriations Budget must be immediately adopted to insure the financial integrity of the City and presented to the County Fiscal Officer by December 31, 2019.. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Council authorizes the Finance Director to change the internal audit classifications of the following fiscal year 2018 expenditures out of the General Fund to certain Special Revenue Funds from "advances" to "transfers", thereby requiring no reimbursement to the General Fund before the end of 2019:
