WHEREAS, R.C. 9.482(B)(1) provides that a political subdivision may enter into an agreement with another political subdivision whereby the contracting political subdivision agrees to render any service for the contracting recipient political subdivision that the contracting recipient political subdivision is otherwise legally authorized to render; and

WHEREAS, Garfield Heights, as the "contracting political subdivision", and the City of Maple Heights, as the "contracting recipient political subdivision", desire to enter into an agreement as authorized by R.C. 9.482(B)(1) whereby Garfield Heights will render, through its Finance Director Biro, municipal finance services to Maple Heights.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO PREPARE AND FILE AN AMENDED 2018 CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED RESOURCES WITH THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, R.C. 5705.36 requires that at the beginning of each fiscal year the Finance Director must certify to the County Fiscal Officer the total amount from all sources available for expenditures from each fund set up in the tax budget, including certain unencumbered balances that existed at the end of the preceding year; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has recommended to Council that he be authorized, pursuant to R.C. 5705.36, to certify and file with the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer an amended official 2018 Certificate of Estimated Resources, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A to reflect the 2018 Final Appropriations Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Finance Director is hereby authorized, pursuant to R.C. 5705.36, to file with the Cuyahoga County Fiscal Officer an amended official 2018 Certificate of Estimated Resources, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, which is incorporated as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in open meetings of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the City's Charter and Codified Ordinances and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby determined to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City and for the further reason to insure the financial integrity of the City and present the amended 2018 Certificate of Estimated Resources to the County Fiscal Officer by December 31, 2018. It shall therefore become effective upon its passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members of Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall become effective at the earliest time allowed by law.
