A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO CHANGE THE INTERNAL AUDIT CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN FISCAL YEAR 2021 EXPENDITURES OUT OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE COPS GRANT FUND FROM ADVANCES TO TRANSFERS, THEREBY CHANGING THE AMOUNT TO BE REIMBURSED TO THE GENERAL FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council passed Ordinance No. 2020-100 on December 16, 2020 for the appropriation of monies for current expenses and other expenditures and provided for an Advance from the General Fund to the COPS Grant Fund; and

WHEREAS, \$78,443.47 of the total \$228,947.96 General Fund advance to the COPS Grant Fund was the City's expense, which should have been accounted for as a Transfer instead of an Advance, thereby requiring the COPS Grant Fund to only reimburse \$150,504.49 to the General Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has recommended to Council that the internal audit classification for the Advance to the COPS Grant Fund be changed accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Council authorizes the Finance Director to make the following changes to the internal audit classification for Fiscal Year 2021 expenditure out of the General Fund to the COPS Grant Fund:

Change total Advance of \$228,947.96 from the General Fund to COPS Grant Fund to an Advance of \$150,504.49 and Transfer of \$78,443.47 from the General Fund to COPS Grant Fund, thereby requiring a reimbursement of \$150,504.49 from the COPS Grant Fund to the General Fund;

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, safety and general welfare of the City and for the further reason that the 2021 advance must be changed to a transfer before the end of 2021 to avoid reimbursement requirements, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
