A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AND MAINTAINING A PEACE GARDEN AT STAFFORD PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that a Peace Garden be established and maintained in Stafford Park located between the baseball diamonds and the forested area behind the concession stand, Southwest of the large parking area as a memorial to victims of violence within the City, as set forth in the attached map.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1.</u> A Peace Garden is hereby established, and shall be maintained by the City, in Stafford Park between the baseball diamonds and the forested area behind the concession stand, Southwest of the large parking area as a memorial to victims of violence within the City, as set forth in the attached map.
- Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, safety and general welfare of the City and for the further reason that establishment and construction of the Peace Garden must begin in a timely fashion, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
