SPECIAL MEETING OF COUNCIL

Council President Jackson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with the following Council members present: Jackson, Jones, Tatum, Anderson, Trojanski and Agee. Councilman Shenett arrived at 6:34 p.m. Councilwoman Madden was absent and excused as she had been delayed and arrived at 6:38 p.m. after the meeting had adjourned. Also present were Police Lt. Swope and Clerk of Council Leonette Cicirella Johnson.

Mr. Jackson said that on the advice of Law Director Consolo it was not necessary to ask for a motion to dispense with all of the regular agenda items except for the legislation since this was a Special Meeting of Council and therefore did not follow Regular Meeting rules.

LEGISLATION:

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-78

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE 2022 ROADWAY REPAIR PROGRAM IN THE CITY OF MAPLE HEIGHTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

This Resolution was on its First Reading.

Councilwoman Agee said she had a question regarding no discussion on this legislation until the August 24, 2022 Special Meeting of Council. She said three (3) members of Council had sent an e-mail to Mr. Jackson on Sunday requesting a Special Meeting to discuss the 2022 Roadway Repair Program, but received no response. Ms. Agee asked why there will be no discussion on this legislation tonight or at the August 18, 2022 Special Meeting.

In response, Mr. Jackson said the meeting notice said First Reading only

Ms. Agee said she did not understand why Council could not discuss the roadway repair program and the incorrect information being disseminated about the vote on the previous legislation. Ms. Agee said everyone talks about needing to work together, but no wants to discuss it with all of Council.

Mr. Jackson said Ms. Agee had her opinion and he had his own opinion. He said there would be discussion at the August 24, 2022 Special Meeting.

Councilwoman Jones asked for a point of order since this discussion was not on the agenda.

There being no further business to come before this Council, Council President Jackson adjourned the meeting at 6:35 p.m.
