MOTION FOR ADOPTION BY:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF TO TRADE-IN \$54,430.00 WORTH OF FIREARMS THAT ARE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES TO KIESLER POLICE SUPPLY FOR CREDIT TOWARDS THE PURCHASE OF \$45,779.20 WORTH OF NEW REPLACEMENT FIREARMS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has determined that the Police Department possesses numerous firearms over ten years old that are no longer needed for a municipal purpose (“the outdated firearms”), which have a fair market value of \$54,430.00; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has arranged for the Police Department to trade-in the outdated firearms to Kiesler Police Supply in exchange for a credit of \$54,430.00 (“trade-in value”) to be used towards the Police Department’s purchase of \$45,779.20 worth of new replacement firearms from Kiesler Police Supply, which trade-in value is established separately from the purchase price of the new replacement firearms; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit 9 - Sale of Personal Property to the City’s Policies and Procedures Manual, adopted by Council by **Ordinance No. 2019-99**, provides that Council approval is needed for the sale or disposal of City-owned property no longer needed for municipal purposes that has an estimated value of greater than \$25,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. Pursuant to Method No. 5 of Exhibit 9 - Sale of Personal Property to the City’s Policies and Procedures Manual, the Police Chief is hereby approved to trade-in the outdated firearms to Kiesler Police Supply in exchange for a credit of \$54,430.00 to be used towards the Police Department’s purchase of \$45,779.20 worth of new replacement firearms from Kiesler Police Supply.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, safety and general welfare of the City and for the further reason to improve the day-day operations of the Police Department, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
