WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission required that the City of Maple Heights provide a commitment for ten percent (10%), or \$4,992.50, of local funds towards the total project cost estimated to be \$49,925.00; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission required that the City confirm that it accepted the funds and intended to complete the Projects in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Engineer had recommended to Council that the City accept the funds and that the Engineer immediately begin the planning and design, bid specifications and cost estimates so that the Project, and bidding said Project, would be completed in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-48, Council authorized and directed the Mayor and/or Engineer to accept the HTCP funding award from the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission, sign and file all necessary documents, prepare plans, bid specifications and cost estimates for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project (County Project No. MAP-22-01), and to provide for bidding said Project so that the City could complete the Project in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer had recommended that the City of Maple Heights immediately move forward with the purchase of 107 trees for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project, using a portion of the HTCP funding award, to insure that such trees would be available for planting by a qualified landscape contractor in the Spring of 2023; and

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ADDING NEW SECTION 240.15 TO THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MAPLE HEIGHTS CREATING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND ENTITLED "PAYROLL CLEARING FUND", FUND NO. 900, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights Finance Department has implemented a new accounting system known as Visual Intelligence Portfolio ("VIP"), which program also processes payroll; and

WHEREAS, VIP requires that a payroll clearing fund be established for management of all payroll related expenses, which is a zero-balance fund which acts as a holding account each payroll period for monies to be deposited into, and then swept out of the account to pay all payroll related expenses for the period; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director recommends that Council approve creation of a special revenue fund entitled "Payroll Clearing Fund", Fund No. 900, to establish a payroll clearing fund for management of all payroll related expenses, which is a zero-balance fund which acts as a holding account each payroll period for monies to be deposited into, and then swept out of the account to pay all payroll related expenses for the period.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> New Section 240.15 is hereby adopted, and added to the Codified Ordinances of the City of Maple Heights, creating a special revenue fund entitled "Payroll Clearing Fund", Fund No. 900, to read as follows:

"240.15 PAYROLL CLEARING FUND

There is hereby created under Ohio R.C. 5705.12, and subject to the approval of the Auditor of the State of Ohio, a Payroll Clearing Fund, designated as **Fund No. 900**. Such Fund shall be used for management of all payroll related expenses, which is a zero-balance fund which acts as a holding account each payroll period for monies to be deposited into, and then swept out of the account to pay all payroll related expenses for the period."

<u>Section 2</u>. The Director of Finance is hereby instructed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Auditor of the State of Ohio pursuant to Auditor of State Bulletin 99-006 for approval of the creation of **Payroll Clearing Fund**, **Fund**. **No. 900**.

Section 3. The Clerk of Council is authorized to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the publisher of the Codified Ordinances of the City for immediate inclusion of

new **Section 240.15** in the current print and electronic editions of the City's Codified Ordinances.
