WHEREAS, the Service Director had informed the Mayor and the City Engineer that the pavement conditions on various streets located within the City of Maple Heights makes it necessary to perform repairs, reconstruction and preventative maintenance on various streets within the City; and

WHEREAS, Council deemed it necessary and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the City residents to perform routine repairs and preventative maintenance on various streets within the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-26, Council authorized and directed the City Engineer to coordinate with the Service Director to update the street inventory which rates pavement conditions for streets based on ODOT's PCR Manual for the Mayor and Council's use in developing and authorizing a road repair program in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2022, the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works informed the Mayor that the Department will reimburse the City for up to One Hundred One Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$101,000.00) in material costs expended on County Routes included under a road repair program in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer had updated the street inventory which rates pavement conditions, including preliminary estimates of costs for pavement repairs, and made a recommendation for the streets, which were determined to be in greatest need of repair, for consideration by the Mayor and Council in authorizing a road repair program; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-58, Council authorized the City Engineer to begin the preparation of plans and specifications and to provide advertising for bids for the 2022 Pavement Repair Program in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2022, the bids for the 2022 Roadway Repair Program were opened and inspected by the City Engineer to determine the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, on August 24, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-78, Council authorized the Mayor, to enter into a contract with Specialized Construction, Inc., for the 2022 Roadway Repair Program, for a cost not to exceed Nine Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand Two Hundred Seventy Dollars and Zero Cents (\$988,270.00), as more fully described in the bid record on file in the Office of the Finance Director in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that the quantity adjustments to contract line items for actual work performed, when combined with the cost of work items not included within the original contract documents, will decrease the contract for the 2022 Roadway Repair Program in the amount of One Hundred Sixty-Six Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Five Dollars and Thirty-Nine Cents (\$166,395.39).

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

WHEREAS, the City Engineer and the Service Director had updated the street inventory which rates pavement conditions, including preliminary estimates of costs for pavement repairs, and made a recommendation for the streets, which were determined to be in greatest need of repair, for consideration by the Mayor and Council in authorizing a road repair program for the 2023 construction season, and

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2023, the Cuyahoga County Department of Public Works informed the Mayor that the Department will reimburse the City for up to Ninety-Two Thousand Four Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$92,400.00) in material costs expended on County Routes included under a road repair program in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, on June 7, 2023, by Resolution No. 2023-53, Council authorized and directed the City Engineer to begin the preparation of plans and specifications and to provide advertising for bids for the 2023 Pavement Repair Program in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, on July 27, 2023, the bids for the 2023 Concrete Roadway Repair Program were opened and inspected by the City Engineer to determine the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2023, by Resolution No. 2023-77, Council authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Set in Stone Contracting, LLC., for the 2023 Concrete Roadway Repair Program, for a cost not to exceed One Hundred Three Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and Zero Cents (\$103,575.00), as more fully described in the bid record on file in the Office of the Finance Director in the City of Maple Heights; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has determined that the quantity adjustments to contract line items for actual work performed, when combined with the cost of work items not included within the original contract documents, will increase the contract for the 2023 Concrete Roadway Repair Program in the amount of Eighteen Thousand Four Hundred Forty-One Dollars and Fifty-Three Cents (\$18,441.53).
