WHEREAS, on February 27, 2023, the Auditor of State issued an engagement letter and agreement dated February 27, 2023 to the City's Finance Director indicating it will audit the City's basic financial statements as of, and for the year ended, December 31, 2022 to express its opinion concerning whether the basic financial statements and related disclosures present fairly, in all material respects, the City's financial position, changes in financial position, required budgetary comparisons, and cash flows (where applicable), in conformity with U.S. generally accepted accounting principles for an amount not to exceed Twenty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Seventy Dollars and Zero Cents (\$27,470.00).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH LONGINO LAWN CARE AND SNOW PLOW TO INSTALL TREES ON HANSEN ROAD, WATSON ROAD AND RAYMOND STREET, FROM NORTHFIELD ROAD TO WARRENSVILLE CENTER ROAD, AS PART OF THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY HEALTHY TREE CANOPY PROGRAM (HTCP) NORTHEAST QUADRANT TREE PLANTING PROJECT (COUNTY PROJECT NO. MAP-22-01), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights, upon application of the City Engineer, was awarded a grant in the amount of Forty-Four Thousand Nine Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$44,923.50) for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project, MAP-22-01 ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission required that the City of Maple Heights provide a commitment for ten percent (10%), or \$4,992.50, of local funds towards the total project cost estimated to be \$49,925.00; and

WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission required that the City confirm that it accepted the funds and intended to complete the Projects in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Engineer had recommended to Council that the City accept the funds and that the Engineer immediately begin the planning and design, bid specifications and cost estimates so that the Project, and bidding said Project, would be completed in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-48, Council authorized and directed the Mayor and/or Engineer to accept the HTCP funding award from the Cuyahoga County Planning Commission, sign and file all necessary documents, prepare plans, bid specifications and cost estimates for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project (County Project No. MAP-22-01), and to provide for bidding said Project so that the City could complete the Project in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer had recommended that the City of Maple Heights immediately move forward with the purchase of One Hundred and Seven (107) trees for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project, using a portion of the HTCP funding award, to insure that such trees would be available for planting by a qualified landscape contractor in the Spring of 2023; and

WHEREAS, on February 15, 2023, by Resolution No. 2023-14, Council authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Rusty Oak Nursery, Ltd., in the amount not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand and Five Hundred Twenty-Three Dollars and Zero Cents (\$24,523.00), to purchase One Hundred and Seven (107) trees for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer sought eight (8) price proposals, and received two (2) price proposals back, for the installation of One Hundred and Seven (107) trees for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project and determined that Longino Lawn Care and Snow Plow, has submitted the lowest and best proposal, which proposal is in the total amount of Twenty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$23,385.50).

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Longino Lawn Care and Snow Plow, in the amount not to exceed Twenty-Three Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$23,385.50), to install One Hundred and Seven (107) trees for the Northeast Quadrant Tree Planting Project, as more fully described in the price proposal on file in the Office of the City Engineer, so that the City will complete the Project in a timely manner pursuant to the terms of the award.

Section 2. The Council of the City of Maple Heights hereby authorizes the Finance Director to amend the appropriations as required for the expenditures outlined within this Resolution.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FIRE CHIEF TO CONTRACT WITH GATCHELL GRANT RESOURCES, LLC TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A FISCAL YEAR 2022 STAFFING FOR ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE GRANT (SAFER GRANT) FOR THE HIRING OF TWO (2) ADDITIONAL FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDICS, AND IF AWARDED, TO ACCEPT THE SAFER GRANT, WITH NO COST SHARE CONTRIBUTION REQUIRED BY THE CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to apply for a fiscal year 2022 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response Grant (SAFER Grant) to receive financial assistance to support the hiring of two (2) additional firefighter/paramedics for a 36-month period; and

WHEREAS, The SAFER Grant is one of three grant programs that constitute the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) focus on enhancing the safety of the public and firefighters with respect to fire and fire-related hazards; and

WHEREAS, the SAFER Grant provides funding directly to fire departments and volunteer firefighter interest organizations to assist in increasing the number of firefighters to help communities meet industry minimum standards and attain 24-hour staffing to provide adequate fire protection from fire and fire-related hazards, and to fulfill traditional missions of fire departments; and

WHEREAS, under the SAFER Grant for hiring of firefighters, grant recipients are not required to contribute a cost share. Salary and associated benefits (actual payroll expenses) for the positions funded under the SAFER Grant are eligible for reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Fire Chief have recommended that the City enter into a contract with Gatchell Grant Resources, LLC ("GGR") to develop and submit on behalf of the City an application for the SAFER Grant to receive financial assistance to support the hiring of two (2) additional firefighter/paramedics for a 36-month period;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAIND,** by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with GGR, which contract is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, to

develop and submit on behalf of the City an application for the SAFER Grant to receive financial assistance to support the hiring of two (2) additional firefighter/paramedics for a 36-month period, with no cost share contribution by the City. In consideration of developing and submitting the grant application, GGR shall be paid a non-refundable fee of Nine Hundred Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$950.00), plus an administration fee in an amount not to exceed Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and Zero Cents (\$3,500.00) if the grant is awarded.

Section 2. Council further authorizes the Mayor to accept the SAFER Grant, if awarded, and authorizes the Finance Director to deposit the funds awarded to the City into the SAFER GRANT FUND, Fund No. 295.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the public safety, health and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to apply for the FY 2022 SAFER Grant by March 17, 2023 and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
