A RESOLUTION DECLARING SEPTEMBER AS INFANT MORTALITY MONTH IN THE CITY OF MAPLE HEIGHTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, infant mortality is defined as the death of an infant before his or her first birthday; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has one of the highest infant mortality rates in the country; and

WHEREAS, Cuyahoga County has the highest infant mortality rate of Ohio's 88 counties; and

WHEREAS, black infants die at a rate almost three (3) times as that of white infants; and

WHEREAS, risk factors that increase the cause of infant deaths include poverty, living in an under-resourced neighborhood, racism, poor nutrition, poor education, stress and the maternal health before and during pregnancy; and

WHEREAS, the City is committed to working with its partners to inform and educate pregnant women and new mothers in an effort to decrease the infant mortality rate in the City of Maple Heights.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. Council thereby declares September as Infant Mortality Month in the City of Maple Heights to acknowledge the nationwide problem and the City's commitment to inform and educate pregnant women and new mothers to an effort to reduce the rate of infant mortality in the City of Maple Heights.
- Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 3. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, safety and general welfare of the City and for the further reason to highlight this issue during the month of September, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
