A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FAMOUS ENTERPRISES INC. FOR A JOB CREATION AND RETENTION PROGRAM GRANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the creation and retention of jobs and employment opportunities are integral to the continued economic health of the City of Maple Heights, Ohio and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the use of governmental resources for the promotion of economic development in the community is in the public interest and is a proper exercise of municipal powers; and

WHEREAS, a Job Creation and Retention Program has been developed to provide incentives to business to create, retain and expand employment opportunities within the City of Maple Heights without utilizing tax revenues or impacting negatively upon the local school system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Maple Heights is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with Famous Enterprises Inc. for a Job Creation and Retention Program Grant whereby the City will award Famous Enterprises Inc. an annual grant payment from City non-tax revenues equal to twenty-five percent (25%) of the income tax withheld on Famous Enterprise Inc.'s employee payroll, for a period of five (5) years, beginning January 1, 2025, with no cap per year, provided that during this five (5) year period commencing January 1, 2025, Famous Enterprises Inc. stays in the City for five (5) years, maintains a minimum annual new or increased payroll of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) and creates five (5) or more new jobs, as more fully outlined in the agreement on file in the Office of the Planning and Development Director.

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2018, the City entered into an agreement with Cuyahoga County to establish and jointly fund the Maple Heights-SBA Small Business Performance Grant Program ("Program"), pursuant to the authorization of **Ordinance No. 2017-112**, enacted November 1, 2017, by which the County would provide funding in an amount not to exceed \$150,000, and through which the City would contribute an additional \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Mayor and Planning and Development Director, Council has determined that the City should provide a forgivable loan through the Program to AB Simmons Incorporated ("the Company") in the amount of \$12,500.00 from the City and a matching amount of \$37,500.00 from County-contributed funds, for a total loan amount of \$50,000.00, to allow the Company to purchase inventory and make interior and exterior enhancements at 20980 Libby Road, Maple Heights, Ohio.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE 2024 EXTERIOR HOME REPAIR GRANT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD FUNDING TO ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Planning and Development Director have proposed a grant program known as the 2024 Exterior Home Repair Grant Program, the terms of which are attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, to provide owners who occupy their homes with financial assistance to maintain the exterior of their homes as a way to preserve and promote the curb appeal of homes in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The 2024 Exterior Home Repair Grant Program, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein, is approved. Council hereby authorizes and approves the Finance Director to fund the 2024 Exterior Home Repair Grant Program by appropriating up to One Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$100,000.00), of which amount only Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$50,000.00) shall be appropriated from the City's funds held at the time of the passage of this Resolution, with the additional amount being appropriated from funds provided to the City from private entities, the County or State, which are specifically designated for the 2024 Exterior Home Repair Grant Program.

Section 2. WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights seeks to make improvements to its existing wastewater facilities by improving sanitary sewers and eliminating sanitary sewer overflow; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights intends to apply for a 2024 Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) Principal Forgiveness loan to fund a portion of the cost of construction of the Southwest Quadrant Sewer Repairs- Phase 2 Project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) requires the governing authority to pass legislation for application of a loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; and

WHEREAS, the City of Maple Heights is a local government eligible to receive Funding for an eligible activity through the Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) Program Year 2024 Final Program Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Engineer have advised Council that 2024 WPCLF Principal Forgiveness funds may be available through the Ohio EPA's Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance (DEFA) and the Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA) in an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Eighty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Dollars and Zero Cents (\$286,850.00), to fund a portion of the Southwest Quadrant Sewer Repairs- Phase 2 Project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Maple Heights, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application, sign and file all necessary contracts and documents with the Ohio EPA's Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance (DEFA) for funding through the 2024 WPCLF Principal Forgiveness loan program for the following project:

Southwest Quadrant Sewer Repairs- Phase 2 Project

Section 2. The dedicated source of repayment will be Maple Heights Water Fund 219.
