WHEREAS, the Police Chief has advised Council that because of recent security and technology requirements demanded by the communications network it utilizes, the Police Department must purchase new Motorola portable radios and related equipment to be able to continue to use its communications network; and

WHEREAS, the Chagrin Valley Dispatch Council ("CVD"), which is a political subdivision of the State of Ohio and supplies the City's dispatching and communications network needs, provided the Police Chief with Estimate No. 1873, dated 02/20/2025 ("Estimate 1873"), for the purchase of fifty (50) Motorola APXN50 700/800 Model 2 Portable Radios with P25 Link Layer Authentication and other related equipment (collectively referred to as "Motorola Radios"), at a total cost of Two Hundred Nine Thousand Five Hundred Twenty-Nine Dollars and Forty-Five Cents (\$209,529.45), with a 3-year lease option with the first year payment deferred, and then three (3) annual payments in the amount of Seventy-Nine Thousand One Hundred Seven Dollars and One Cent (\$79,107.01), all as is more fully set forth in Estimate No. 1873, which is on file in the Office of the Finance Director and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Sections 9.48, 9.482 and 735.053, and Exhibit 7 to the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures, Exceptions To Public Bidding, Section (9) - Intergovernmental Purchases, all provide that a political subdivision may authorize the appropriate official to enter into a contract, without advertising and bidding, for the purchase of material, equipment, or supplies from another political subdivision of the State; and

WHEREAS, on August 2, 2023, by Resolution No. 2023-79, Council authorized the City Engineer to begin the preparation of plans and specifications and to provide advertising for bids for the Southgate Park Boulevard Reconstruction Project and to also continue to seek additional outside funding for the project while the plan preparation is underway and adjust the project schedule as required to secure additional funds; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell is a service cooperative established by Minn. Stat. § 123A.21 as a local unit of government pursuant to the Minn. Const. art. XII, sec. 3 and is authorized to provide a Cooperative Purchasing Program by Minn. Stat. §123A.21, subd. 7(23) to participating entities; and

WHEREAS, participation in Sourcewell's Cooperative Purchasing Program is open to eligible participating entities registering with Sourcewell, including: a state, city, county, town, village, school district, or political subdivision of any state of the United States; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is a member of, and participating entity in, Sourcewell's Cooperative Purchasing Program (Member No. 105385); and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell's Cooperative Purchasing Program provides purchasing that is "Procurement conducted by, or on behalf of, one or more Public Procurement Units" as defined by the American Bar Association Model Procurement Code for State and Local Governments and Sourcewell's analysts streamline the procurement process by developing requests for proposal (RFPs) and invitations for bids (IFBs) for national, competitive solicitations that meet or exceed local requirements; and

WHEREAS, Sourcewell, on August 9, 2022, advertised for RFPs to be submitted by September 27, 2022 (RFP No. 092722) for Conducted Energy Weapons and AXON Enterprises, Inc. submitted a proposal, and on December 20, 2022 (Resolution No. 2022-34) awarded a contract to AXON Enterprise, Inc. to provide Conducted Energy Weapons for purchase through Sourcewell's Cooperative Purchasing Program (Contract No. 092722-AXN), which contract is good to November 21, 2026; and

WHEREAS, R.C. 9.48(B)(2) and (C) permits the City to participate in a joint purchasing program like Sourcewell's Cooperating Purchase Program and is exempt from Ohio's competitive bidding requirements because Contract No. 092722-AXN was awarded pursuant to a publicly solicited request for a proposal by Sourcewell, a political subdivision of another state; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has advised Council that the City is in need of new and additional Tasers, and recommends purchasing from AXON Enterprise, Inc., per its February 4, 2025 Quote No. Q-662595-45692.953JC, on file with the Police Department, and per Sourcewell

Contract No. 092722-AXN, forty (40) AXON Taser 10, and related equipment, including cartridges and battery packs, and training sessions, in the total amount of Two Hundred Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$213,184.00), payable over 5 years beginning June 2025 through June 2029, in five (5) annual payments of Forty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$42,636.80); and

WHEREAS, Council desires to follow the recommendation of the Police Chief and authorize the purchase from AXON Enterprise, Inc., per its February 4, 2025 Quote No. Q-662595-45692.953JC, and per Sourcewell Contract No. 092722-AXN, forty (40) AXON Taser 10, and related equipment, including cartridges and battery packs, and training sessions, in the total amount of Two Hundred Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$213,184.00), payable over 5 years beginning June 2025 through June 2029, in five (5) annual payments of Forty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Eighty Cents (\$42,636.80).

The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with AXON Enterprise, Inc., per its February 4, 2025 Quote No. Q-662595-45692.953JC (a copy of which is on file with the Police Department and incorporated as if fully rewritten herein), and per Sourcewell Contract No. 092722-AXN, for the purchase of forty (40) AXON Taser 10, and related equipment, including cartridges and battery packs, and training sessions, in the total amount of Two Hundred Thirteen Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars and Zero Cents (\$213,184.00), payable over 5 years beginning June 2025 through June 2029, in five (5) annual payments of Forty-Two Thousand Six Hundred Thirty-Six Dollars and Eighty Cents \$42,636.80).

<u>Section 2</u>: The Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase referred to in Section 1 above, in the total amount of \$213,184.00, payable over 5 years beginning June 2025 through June 2029, in five annual payments of \$42,636.80.

<u>Section 3.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting on the date indicated below, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution constitutes an emergency measure necessary for the public peace, safety and general welfare of the City and for the further reason that the Taser order must be timely placed to avoid delivery delays and price increases, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
