## District 2 Road and Sewer Work

### *Updates on completed work and this year's upcoming projects*

James Avenue sewer work has been completed and the  
road repaving has gone out to bid. This work is being  
done through the NEORS and the new road is at no cost  
to taxpayers. A huge thank you to those residents who  
weathered the many water line breaks and general  
inconvenience during this project.

Phase 3 of the Southeast Sewer District Repairs Project  
is estimated at \$832,000, which will include the area of  
Glenwood Avenue to Lee Road South and from Ramage  
to Turney Road. The work is covered through grants  
secured by the Ohio Public Works Commission and  
NEORS. Work on this project will begin this summer.  
MorningStar will be resurfaced at the completion of this  
project.

Rockside Road resurfacing is also scheduled for this year  
with the help of a 2.3 million dollar grant from the  
Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency (NOACA).
