September is National Prostate Cancer Awareness Month


During National Prostate Cancer Awareness Month, we support those diagnosed with prostate cancer through research, education, and access to prevention, treatment, and follow-up care and support.

Prostate cancer is the second most common cancer among men in the United States. All men are at risk for prostate cancer. About 13 out of 100 American men will get prostate cancer during their lifetime, and about 2 to 3 men will die from prostate cancer.

The most common risk factor is age. The older a man is, the greater the chance of getting prostate cancer.

Different people have different symptoms and some men do not have symptoms at all, but they can include:

- Difficulty starting urination
- Weak or interrupted flow of urine
- Frequent urination, especially at night
- Difficulty emptying the bladder completely



- Pain or burning during urination
- Blood in the urine
- Pain in the back, hips, or pelvis that doesn't go away

If you have any symptoms that worry you, be sure to see your doctor right away.


