- Trash: Large objects such as appliances (refrigerators and freezer must have doors removed), water tanks, and furniture are picked up from the tree lawn on regular collection days. Please call 216-587-9014 to have bulky items picked up. Mattresses and box springs MUST be Wrapped in plastic bag! Cloth or upholstered furniture must also be wrapped in plastic!!
- Trash may be placed on the tree lawn no earlier than 6:00 PM the day before collection, and cans must be removed from the tree lawn no later than 6:00 AM the following day.
- Trash Holiday Schedule: Thanksgiving trash collection will have a one (1) day delay Christmas – trash collection may be delayed by one (1) day. City Hall Elevator and Vestibule Update "Masons laid the block walls for the elevator shaft and the support columns for the new foyer area. A picture of the progress is included below. Next steps include getting a roof on the elevator shaft and enclosing the foyer area so work can continue as under cover as winter approaches. The project remains approximately on schedule". - Door-to-Door Inspection Program The Department of Building will inspect all residential properties in the City on a 5-year rotating basis in each of the 7 Council Districts per year. To begin the Program, the Department has identified a street, or section of small streets, in each Council District to inspect this Fall, 2021. In some Districts, these inspections have already begun. The Annual Door-to-Door Inspection Program will begin again in Spring 2022.
