Infrastructure – Upon completion of sewer repairs to Hansen, Watson and Raymond (Warrensville to Northfield), look for these roadways to get resurfaced in September/October. In addition, look for Franklin and Hilgrove to receive watermain replacements and street resurfacing in 2023.

Stafford Park Improvements – On June 5th, the city's Sprayground opened at Stafford Park. This is phase one of returning the aquatics program to Maple Heights residents. The next phase is reopening the swimming pool. Free to residents: Open Noon-7pm Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays; closed on Mondays and Wednesdays.
