### CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

March 31, 2021

Dear Residents:

This letter is to provide a project update for all residents affected by the Dunham Road project. Construction began on schedule on January 04, 2021. The project remains on schedule and at this time it is expected that all construction work will be completed in mid-June of 2021.

Please note that in the near future the construction activity will shift from the west side of the roadway to the east side of the Dunham Road pavement. Traffic will continue to be restricted to southbound only and vehicles will be directed to drive on the west side, or the normal legal side, of the road. As previously stated, Dunham Road will remain restricted to southbound only traffic throughout the duration of the project.

At this time, all of the underground utility work including manhole/catch basin modifications and installations, storm and sanitary sewer repairs, and all water main related work has been completed. There are no additional water service interruptions planned in the future.

Please remember that when concrete replacement work is being performed directly in front of driveways access to the drive may not be possible. The exact timing of drive access disruptions is difficult to schedule in advance and the contractor will provide door hanger notifications, and attempt to personally notify affected properties, at least the day before such disruptions will occur. In such cases residents will be permitted to park along side streets (Florence, Woodbrook, Longvale, Corkhill, and Mendota) during the daytime and overnight while drive access is not available. Parking will not be permitted on Schreiber Road but residents may park on the school bus turnaround located between Schreiber and Florence. Residents may also decide to coordinate parking with a neighbor who may still have driveway access available.

This office will provide further construction updates and notifications to all affected residents, as the work progresses.

We have passed the half-way point on this project and recognize the inconvenience to all affected parties. Your continued patience and cooperation with this important project is greatly appreciated.
