Maple Heights Mayor's Court COVID-19 Bond Leniency

The Maple Heights Mayor's Court (MHMC) has set up a process to help those who may have warrants or capiases, but are not able to pay for bonds at this time. This program allows anyone who has a qualifying, non-violent misdemeanor warrant or capias to be given a new court date without an arrest or posting bond. Garfield Heights Municipal Court (GHMC) is doing a similar program called eSafe Surrender.

Here is how the program works:

If you have a warrant (non-violent misdemeanor) for your arrest-

- Come to the police station (5373 Lee Rd., Maple Heights, OH 44137)
- Give us your current contact information
- We will give a new court date.
- You will not be arrested
 - you will be served with your warrant and given a new court date and a phone number and/or email to contact the court.

If you have a capias:

- Contact the Maple Heights Police Records Department. (by phone or in person)
- Give your current contact information
- You will be given the next available court date

If you have a Garfield Heights Municipal Court (GHMC) warrant or capias:

- Contact GHMC through their website or via this email: safe@ghmc.org
- Contact Maple Heights Records Department and we will collect your information and pass it along to GHMC for processing.
