CARE is a Membership Program that offers services focused on helping older adults age in place with dignity. Services are completed by Volunteers and include projects in and around the home. The program is managed by the CARE Program Coordinator who works closely with the CARE partners representing each community to expand access to residents.

OUR VOLUNTEERS

Our diverse and dedicated Volunteers includes individuals, couples, faith based groups, coworkers, students, youth, families and friends from a wide array of backgrounds, skills and abilities. Some Volunteers sign up for one day yard care opportunities, while others have been with CARE since the beginning and volunteer regularly.



SERVICES

Services are based on your personalized CARE Plan. Services can include Battery and Bulb Changes, Home Organization, Kitchen Care, Minor Repairs, Seasonal Tasks, Technology Assistance, Trash Removal, Window Care, Yard Care ...And More. Tools are often provided by Volunteers, supplies are provided by Member.

*Services CARE does not provide include mowing, snow removal, electrical, plumbing, gutter cleaning or services requiring a professional or the use of a ladder.
