The Maple Heights Food Pantry has been selected as a distribution center for the Greater Cleveland Food Bank's Emergency food box program. The Greater Cleveland Food Bank (GCFB) in partnership with **DOORDASH** delivers emergency food boxes to homebound individuals within the GCFB service area. Homebound individuals who are in need of emergency food can contact the GCFB and GCFB coordinates with DoorDash for delivery of a box of shelf stable food. All of these requests must be made through the GCFB directly.

Additionally, The Maple Heights Food Pantry is pleased to announce their participation in Direct Drop; through a partnership established between the Greater Cleveland Food Bank (GCFB), *COSTCO*, and giant eagle.

This program makes excess unsold products from Costco and Giant Eagle available to the Greater Cleveland Food Bank. These products are then distributed to partner agencies in the GCFB network such as our Maple Heights Food Pantry for distribution to program participants. Through these partnerships our residents are provided with items that we would otherwise be unable to make available to them.
