DOMINION EAST OHIO GAS UPGRADE WORK; E. 141st & BRUNSWICK AVE. PIR-3002 CONSTRUCTION START: MONDAY APRIL 22, 2024

Dominion East Ohio Gas will be continuing their upgrades to the natural gas transmission and distribution system in the City of Maple Heights. Dominion Project PIR-3002 will include work to upgrade gas mains and service connections on the following streets:

- Dunham Road between Brunswick Avenue & Krems Avenue
- Brunswick Avenue between Dunham Road & E 141st Street
- Tokay Avenue between Dunham Rd. & E 141st Street
- E 141st St. between Brunswick Avenue and Rockside Road

The work will include the replacement of approximately 13,000 feet of low pressure gas line, 250 residential service connections from main to curb and 187 residential service connections from curb to meter. 240 meters will also be moved or relocated. All residents that will be directly affected by these upgrades have been previously notified by Dominion. The area of construction is shown below:

The contractor is scheduled to begin construction on, or about, <u>Monday April 22, 2024.</u> The majority of the work will utilize directional drilling to minimize open cut excavation and disruptions to traffic and driveway access during construction. Smaller excavated areas will be required at all service connections to the newly installed main. The City's construction inspection firm, Quality Control Inspection (QCI), will be providing inspection for this project and areas disturbed during construction will be restored to original, or better, condition when the project is finished.

Temporary lane closures will be required at various times throughout construction and the contractor will be using flaggers to direct traffic. Please proceed with caution through the work zone for your safety and the safety of the construction workers. If work is occurring directly in front of your house, you may temporarily lose access to your driveway. The contractor will provide 24-hour notice if this is likely to occur, and they will work to restore access to your driveway as soon as work progresses past your driveway.
