D.E. Williams Electric Company will be starting construction of lighted bollards along the pedestrian path in the Lee-Libby Pocket Park in the City of Maple Heights. Underground electric cables will also be installed to provide power for the lighting.:



The contractor is scheduled to begin construction on <u>Friday May 31, 2024.</u> The initial work will be excavating for concrete foundation holes for the eleven (11) planned bollards. The majority of the underground work will utilize directional drilling to eliminate the need for open cutting the walkways in the park. A pedestal mounted electrical panel will also be installed as part of the project work.

The sidewalk entrances through the park will be closed while this project is under construction. Please do not attempt to walk through the park once the sidewalk closures have been posted.
